

Dahlgren Township August 10, 2026 Monthly Meeting

The Dahlgren Township Board of Supervisors met for a monthly meeting at the East Union Lutheran Church Parish Center on August 10, 2026. Present were Chairman Jeff Thompson, Supervisor Brian Gennrich, Supervisor Keith Kooiman, Clerk Mary Olson and Treasurer Doran Brahee. Also present were William Windhorst, Heather Tran, Russ Dunker, Tony Schuster, Dan Groen, Khai Tran and Ron Olson.

Chairman Thompson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

The Township Meeting Minutes were typed and emailed out to Board Members. On Motion by Supervisor Kooiman and seconded by Supervisor Gennrich to approve the minutes. Vote-aye-all-approved.

William Windhorst:

- The residents of the Pinto Valley Plat (Carver Highlands) are seeking Township Board approval to engage a surveyor at their expense to re-draw the dedicated roadway easements dedicated in the 9/28/2001 plat so as to conform to the current property landforms, maintenance and uses. The topic was tabled until the next meeting and the Board will get the information needed to vacate the road.

- Announced that he was running for County Commissioner and spoke of what his platform will be and asked for support from the Township.

Road Report:

- The second application for dust control is tentatively set for August 20, 2026.
- Mt. Carmel patchwork is complete. Will need to discuss in the future if the asphalt sections need more work in the future.
- Tree trimming – Supervisor Gennrich will meet with EB Tree Trimming to discuss which trees need to be trimmed. On motion by Supervisor Gennrich and seconded by Chairman Thompson that the tree trimming will not exceed \$10,000.00. Vote-aye-all-approved.
- The Maplewood Road bridge replacement will take place in 2027, there is no need to purchase any resident land, the County will just need a temporary access easement during bridge replacement.

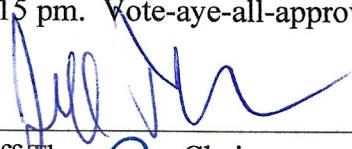

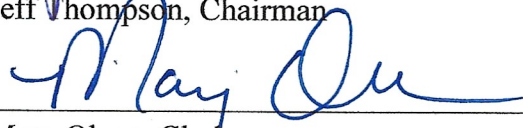
